Announcement

General:

The **Swiss Ice Skating Open 2025** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications. (Novice Categories Single & Pair Skating will be held in accordance with ISU Communications 2699 and subsequent updates.)

Participation is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regards to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

World Standing

Points:

In case the requirements as per ISU Communication 2550 are fulfilled, World Standing points will be awarded in the Senior Categories: Men, Women, Ice Dance and Pairs.

Entries:

All Entries must be made by the ISU Member concerned based on the regulations for all International Competitions in Figure Skating 2025/26. All entries for the Swiss Ice Skating Open 2025, must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated.

Each ISU Member may nominate up to three (3) competitors / couples for each event at the Swiss Ice Skating Open. The OC limits the number of entries to 30 Women and 30 Men, 16 Pairs and 20 Ice Dance couples in Junior and Senior categories and 32 Boys and 32 Girls in Advanced Novice categories.-In case of a higher number of entries, the OC may limit the number of final entries available for members.

The organizer reserves the right to enter more athletes from his country.

Advanced Novice categories, Boy and Girls: Each ISU Member may nominate up to three (3) competitors for each category at the Swiss Ice Skating Open.

Members are welcome to add names of substitute Skaters/Ice Dance couples. Based on the total number of entries in each category, the OC will decide, how many substitute Skaters/Ice Dance couples are accepted. The number of entries of the host member is not limited.

be accepted by the Organizing Committee with a late surcharge of € 20 for Single Skater and € 30 for Pairs / Ice Dance couples

been transferred into the organizer's account. Members concerned

will receive confirmation.

Expenses of Competitors:

The organizer will not cover any expenses of competitors.

Officials: Members are kindly requested to nominate one International/ISU

Judge for Figure Skating and for Ice Dance. Judges qualified for both disciplines are very welcome. All entries of officials for the Swiss Ice Skating Open 2025, must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated. The organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of Judges in case of too many nominations. The composition of the panels will

be finalized after the entry deadline. It will be sent to the participating members in time. The organizer will cover accommodation and meals for accepted Judges/Technical

Officials.

The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online
Registration System (ORS) not later than September 15, 2025

- 20:00 hours local time.

Time Schedule: The competition is scheduled to start on Thursday, October 23,

2025, and end on Sunday, October 26, 2025. A definitive schedule will be sent to all participating members on September 29, 2025. A

short practice is planned for all categories and segments.

Airport/transport: It is recommended to fly to Geneva, from where a regular train

service is provided to reach the city of Lausanne. The organizer does not provide any transportation for athletes, coaches, team

leaders and chaperons.

Accommodation: The organizer is in charge of hotel arrangements for accepted Judges

and Technical Officials.

Accreditation:

The official accreditation is located at the main entrance of the Ice Rink. Accreditation will be given to Competitors, Coaches, Judges, as well as to Team Officials, as long as they are officially entered via the ISU ORS system.

Draws:

The Initial Draws are conducted prior to the event. There will be no intermediate Draws. The starting order of the FS/FD is the reverse order of the result of the SP/RD. The draw will take place online on 17 October 2025.

Results:

The determination and publication of the results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, Rule 352 and 353 and subsequent updates.

Awards:

The first three placed Skaters/Ice Dance couples in each discipline are awarded Trophies or Medals.

Liability:

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Swiss Ice Skating Open 2025 in Figure Skating and Ice Dance, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials, and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person. The organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors, Coaches, Officials, or other participating persons.
