On frozen Lake St. Moritz
Ladies and Men - All Distances

Swiss Ice Skating will organize the Speed Skating Swiss Championships 2019 on the frozen lake St. Moritz. It will be held under the regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU). A standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at the lake of St. Moritz, an open air natural ice rink in St. Moritz, Switzerland. The radii of the inner and outer curves competition lanes are with radius of 25.5 and 29.5 meters, respectively a warm-up track. In addition to the Swiss Championships I have the honor and pleasure to invite you to the second **St. Moritz Open** for national and International speed skaters.

Licence Participants must be a member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU. *Swiss Skaters must have a licence from the Swiss Ice Skating Federation.* If you have no licence you may get from the organizer a **temporary starting licence** for € 20 / CHF 25 per Racing day or €30.00 / CHF 40.00 for the Weekend.

Protocol All participants will receive a protocol with end times.

Doping control May be made in accordance with ISU rules.

Entry fee € 15.00 / CH 20.00 per distance or € 30.00 / CHF 35.00 per racing day
In addition € 10.00 / CH 15.00 per Training day
