5) Selection process	Apart from the skaters already nominated (see line item 3), the following criteria apply for the remaining slots/substitute slots provided the athletes are likely to fulfill the goals set forth by Swiss Ice Skating as indicated above: 1) Taking into account the two highest competition scores (total score) achieved in competitions covered under line time 4; 2) The final placelacement in the Swiss Senior Championships 2024. These results will have a greater impact in the decision making process for the remaining slots; 3) Other factors, such as health, performance trajectory, will be considered, if necessary. The final selection decision will be made by the Board of Swiss Ice Skating.
