

## JGP ASSIGNMENT IN FIGURE SKATING - 2023-24 SEASON

### 1<sup>ST</sup> COMMUNICATION

#### 1) Preselection:

- Members of the **National Team Elite+U19+U17** who are eligible in junior category for the 2023-24 season, are invited to participate in the selection for the **Junior Grand Prix Series (JGP)** in Figure Skating for the 2023-24 season.
- According to the [announcement of the JGP series 2023-24](#), Swiss Ice Skating can enter athletes in the following events:

04.-07.10.2023	<b>JGP Yerevan</b> (ARM)	Women: <b>1</b> / Men: <b>0</b>
- **Naoki Rossi** (Men) is automatically awarded **two** spots of his choice: **JGP Osaka** (JPN) + one more to be decided.
- **Swiss Ice Skating** relinquished the two spots in the Men JGP event in **Bangkok** (THA) and in **Yerevan** (ARM), respectively one spot in **Osaka** (JPN).
- **As for the Women JGP spots, there might be additional spots that will be awarded to Swiss Ice Skating from federations that will return spots.**

- The **Test Skate** in **Bäretswil** will consist of the presentation of a **Free Skating program junior performance + some junior Short Program elements** which will be judged according to the ISU rules in force for the season 2023-24 (<https://isu.org/inside-isu/isu-communications/communications/31153-isu-communication-2558/file>).
- The total points (TSS) in the **Free Skating program** as well the jumping passes outlined below will be considered for the ranking. Each jumping pass is to be presented twice (the better element is considered for the ranking):
  - 3+3 combination (for Women: also possible 3F+2T or 3F+2Lo)
  - 3Lz
- There is no registration fee. Participants are responsible for their own expenses and insurance coverage.
- The **Test Skate** in **Bäretswil** will be held in the afternoon. The draw will be done electronically, and the starting order will be indicated on the convocation which will be sent by the Swiss Ice Skating secretariat in due time.
- After the performances the selection committee will review the results and make a proposal for the allocation of available spots for the **JGP series 2023-24**. This also includes substitutes.
- Important: It is to be noted that **Swiss Ice Skating** reserves the right to not fill every spot. Allocating spots depends upon the performance/level of the athletes.
- In case of illness, injury or other compelling reason that will prevent the athlete from competing in the Test Skate, the selection committee may nonetheless consider the athlete for JGP series.
- In the same sense, the selection committee/Swiss Ice Skating is to decide on all exceptional cases.
- The **Test-Skate (SP+FP)** planned on **11.-12.08.2023** in **Dübendorf**, could complete this selection if necessary.
