

JGP ASSIGNMENT IN ICE DANCE – 2023-24 SEASON

- Members of the **National Team A**, who are eligible in the junior category for the 2023-24 season, are invited to be considered in the selection for the **Junior Grand Prix Series (JGP)** in Ice Dance for the 2023-24 season. A planification of international competitions on the Junior circuit in view of a possible selection to the **Junior World Championships 2024** is mandatory.

- According to the [announcement of the JGP series 2023-24](#), **Swiss Ice Skating** can enter couples in the following events:

30.08.-02.09.2023	JGP Linz	(AUT)	1
06.-09.09.2023	JGP Istanbul	(TUR)	1
27.-30.09.2023	JGP Gdansk	(POL)	1
04.-07.10.2023	JGP Yerevan	(ARM)	1

- As result of PISTE 2023, according to the results in the competitions during the 2022-23 season and above requirements to participate in **JGP series 2023-24**, only 2 couples which are members of the **National Team A (Junior)**, are considered into the selection:

- **Gina Zehnder / Beda Leon Sieber** → **2 spots**
- **Maëlle Ledermann / Antonin Emo** → **2 spots**

- While taking into consideration, respecting the following rules:

➔ **Gina Zehnder / Beda Leon Sieber** will choose their 2 spots (1 spot among **JGP Linz** and **JGP Istanbul** and 1 spot among **JGP Gdansk** and **JGP Yerevan**) and **Maëlle Ledermann / Antonin Emo** will be assigned to the 2 other spots left.

➔ The national ice dance coach and the head of performance will confirm the selection on **July 3, 2023**, depending on a **Free Dance program control** on **Friday, June 30, 2023** in **Dübendorf** (during the Ice Dance Team Meeting).

➔ The participation in the 2nd spot will be subject to evaluation by the selection committee/Swiss Ice Skating according to the performance achieved in the 1st spot.

➔ In the same sense, the selection committee/Swiss Ice Skating is to decide on all exceptional cases.
